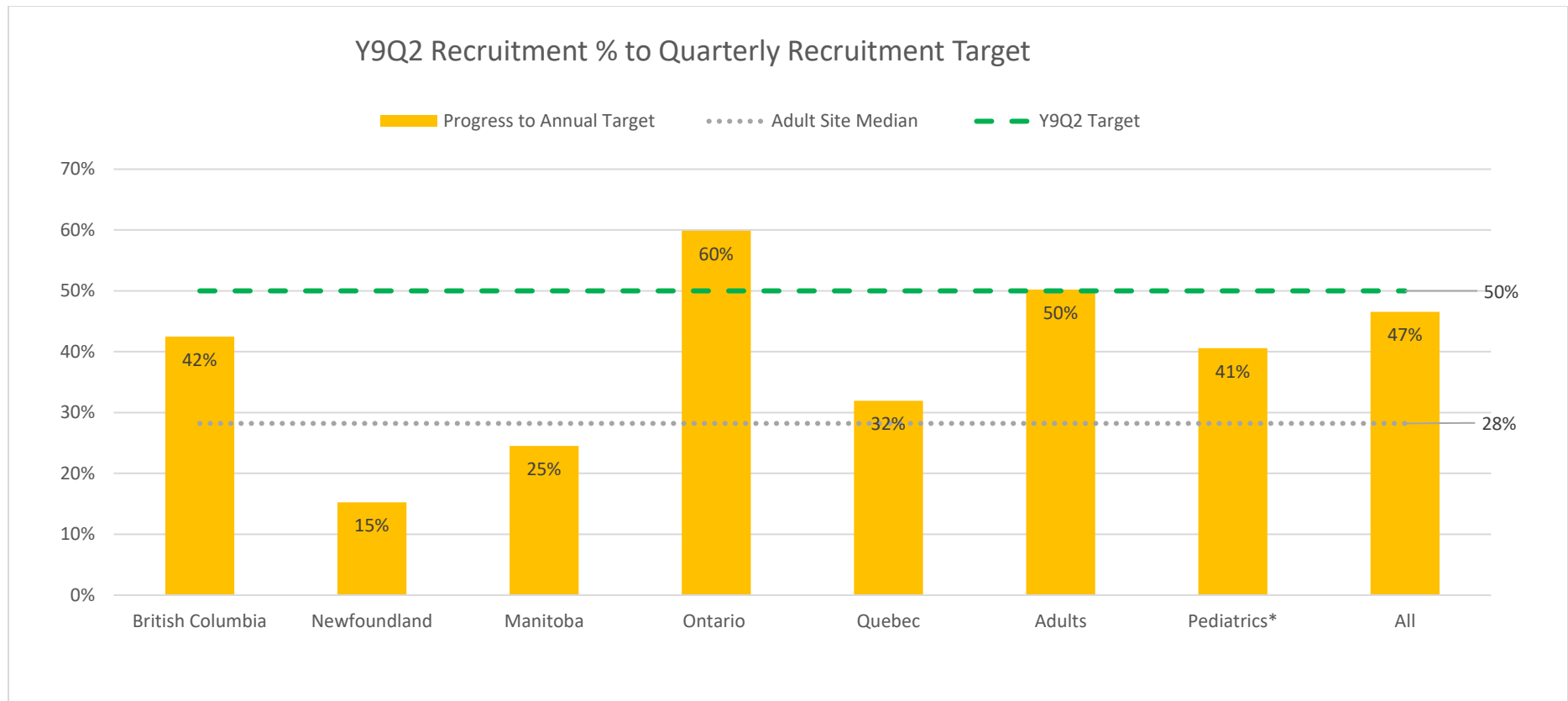

Section A: Patient Access and Recruitment to the 3CTN Portfolio Trials

Patient Recruitment at All Network Sites

Objective: To improve patient access to academic clinical trials and improve patient recruitment by greater than 100% within five years.



Notes:

- 841 patients were recruited (771 to Adult and 70 to Pediatric cancer centres) to Portfolio trials in Quarter 2, bringing the Y9 Network total to 1885.
- Overall, ~33% of Adult Sites (13 out of 39) are on track to meet their Y9 target.
- *Pediatric progress to pre-3CTN baseline recruitment is shown. Currently 53% of Pediatric sites (7 out of 13) are on track to meet or exceed their pre-3CTN baseline in Y9.

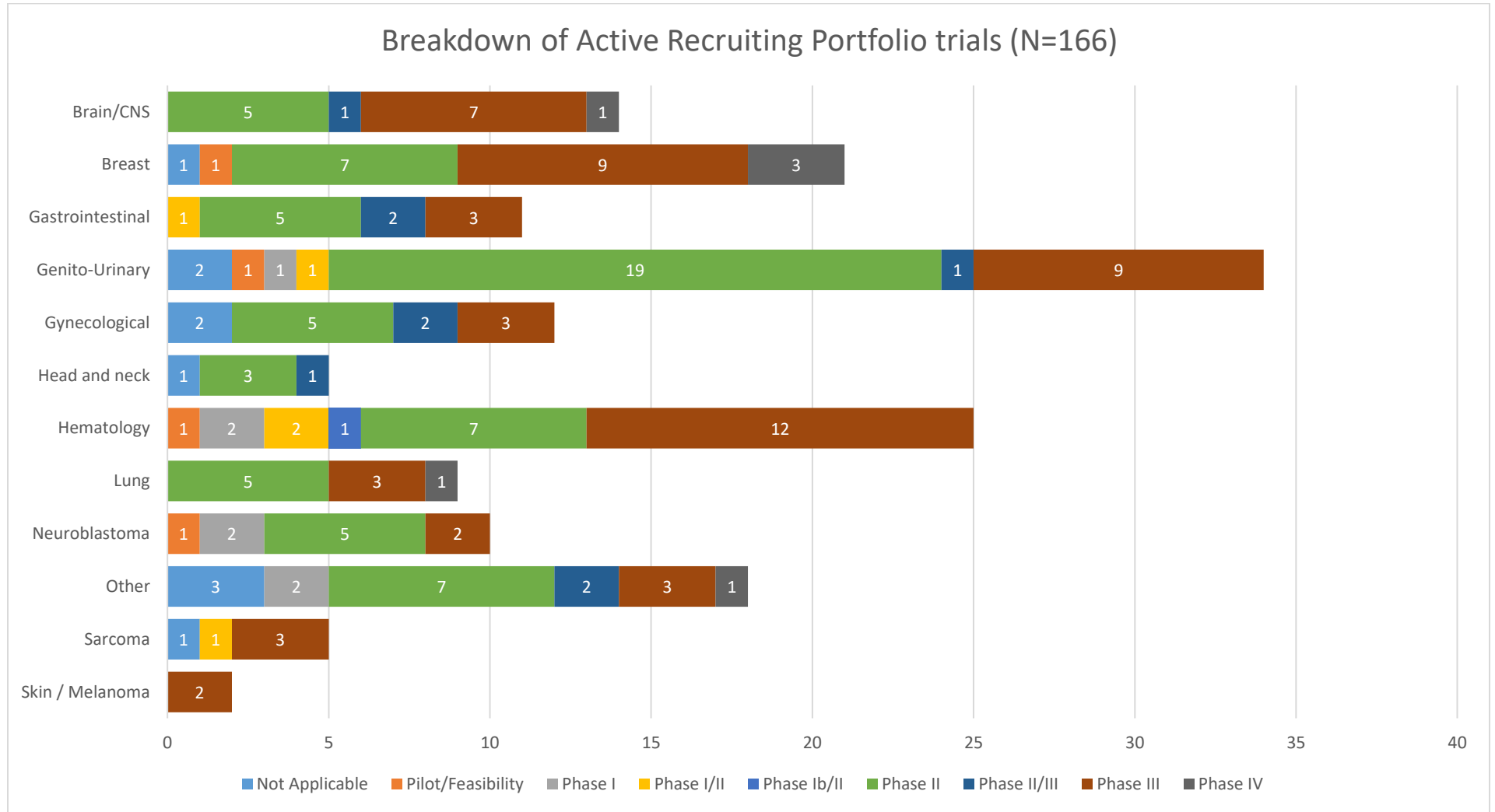
